

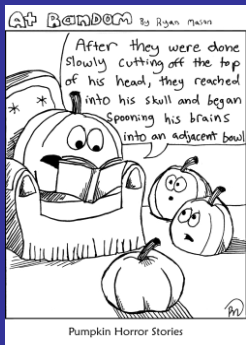

You are never too old to dress up for Halloween... Here are some cheap ideas...
