

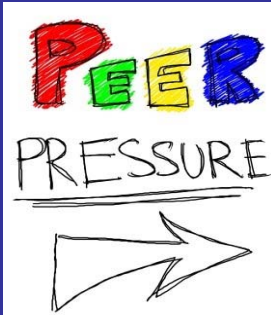

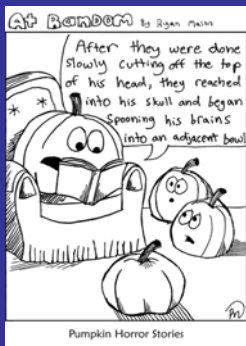

## Dealing with Peer Pressure

Saying "no" is a really tough thing to do. Pay attention to your own feelings about what is right or wrong. Select friends that share your same ethics and values. If you choose friends who don't use drugs, cut class, smoke, or lie to their parents, then you probably won't do these things either, even if other kids do.

If you continue to face peer pressure and are having a hard time dealing with it, talk to someone you trust. Talking to a parent, teacher or school counselor can help you feel better and prepare you for the next time you face peer pressure.
